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Midlands STEM Institute 2021-2022 Title I Plan Summary

Funds will be spent to employ 3 X 1.0 FTE instructional assistants to work with at risk students in ELA and Math in grades K-8th. The purpose of these positions is to help at-risk students set and reach academic goals.

Funds will be spent to employ 1 FTE Instructional Coach Curriculum/Instruction to work with at risk students in ELA and Math in Grades 7-12. The purpose of this position is to help at-risk students set and reach academic goals by providing professional development and coaching to teachers to align standards to the Curriculum maps and lesson plans.

Funds will be spent to purchase supplies and materials for family STEM Nights, Tech Nights, and Awards Programs. The purpose of these supplies is to provide events to involve parents in their child's education and increase student achievement.

Funds will be spent on classroom materials and supplies for all students. The purpose of this is to purchase additional classroom supplies, teaching materials, data collection materials, textbooks, and reading program books. It will also provide storage for these items.

Funds will be spent to purchase iPads for students in grade K. The purpose of these devices is to enable one-to-one technology use for all students to have access to software and instructional programs to increase student achievement.

Funds will be spent to purchase instructional software or site licenses for students in grade K-12.

Funds will be spent to purchase Practice Coach Plus books. The purpose of these books is to prepare students in grades 3-8 for state assessments.

Funds will be spent to purchase supplemental instructional supplies for all students. The purpose of these materials is to increase student achievement by providing materials to support math and science instruction for students.
